These are the basic variables available in Census 2000 that can be used to create indicators reflecting the circumstances of children. Each section begins with an *italicized* description of whether the data are available for (1) children only, (2) all persons in the home, (3) the housing unit. Each variable follows with a list of categories for the variable.

The following are variables available for children only

How persons in the child's home are related to the child (number)

- * Parent
- * Sibling
- * Grandparent
- * Other relatives
- * Non-relatives
- * It is possible to identify children who are foster children

Responsible grandparent

- * Yes/No ... Grandparent in home responsible for most of child's basic needs
- * If yes, how long grandparent has been responsible for child
 - * Less then 1 month
 - * 1-6 months
 - * 7-12 months
 - * more than 12 months

The following variables are available for all persons (children, parents, etc.)

Age

* By single year of age

Sex

- *Male
- *Female

Marital Status

- * Married (spouse present or spouse absent)
- * Widowed
- * Divorce
- * Separated
- * Never married

School Attendance

- * No
- * Yes, public school

Grade or level of school attending

- * Nursery school, preschool
- * Kindergarten

Number of rooms in housing unit

* 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, or 9+

Number of bedrooms in housing unit

* 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5+

Housing unit has complete plumbing facilities

(hot/cold piped water, flush toilet, bathtub/shower)
* Yes/No

Housing unit has complete kitchen facilities

(sink with piper water, range/stove, refrigerator) * Yes/No

Telephone service available in housing unit

* Yes/No

Fuel most used for heating in housing unit

* Gas (piped), gas (bottled) electricity, fuel oil/kerosene, coal/coke, wood, or solar

Number of vehicles at home available for use of household
