Herbst/Tekin (2010c)	ECLS K	5-year-olds of single mothers	<ul> <li>4.9 point ↓ in reading test scores</li> <li>3.7 point ↓ in math test scores</li> <li>7.1 point ↑ in externalizing behaviors</li> <li>2.9 point ↑ in internalizing behaviors</li> </ul>

# Directions for Future Research on Parental Work and Earnings

- Make greater use of longitudinal data
  - Shift focus from short- to long-term employment outcomes
  - How many parents are working prior to subsidy utilization?
- Emphasize parental earnings
- Expand list of work-related outcomes
  - Full-time versus part-time work
  - Educational attainment
  - Job training activities
- Understand the deeper qualities of parental work
  - Standard versus nonstandard work hours
  - Occupational category
  - Work conditions

## Directions for Future Research on Family Well-Being

### Child well-being

- Focus on building a systematic body of knowledge
- Long-term effects: Can school experiences mediate?
- Shift focus from preschool- to school-age children
- Explore whether the age and intensity of subsidy receipt matter
- Different children, different effects?

### Parental well-being

- Explore physical and mental health outcomes
- Child-parent interactions and parenting behavior
- Substance abuse and risky behaviors
- Does job- and child care-type mediate these effects?
